Ink and toner recycling

Ink and Toner Recycling (ITR) specialise in the management and recycling of used printer cartridges.

Simply use a box to store used printer cartridges.

Once full, contact your account manager or corporate@alzheimersresearchuk.org to organise a free collection from your office.

Depending on their condition, they will either recycle any unusable cartridges or reuse and resell them, donating the market value to Alzheimer's Research UK.
